For those who may not have copies of these publications, we will be at the Church this coming Saturday (3/21), from 11 a.m. to 12 noon, to distribute copies to you. Additionally, although we will not be physically using the building, the Church's expenses (i.e., mortgage & insurance) still must be paid. To that end, we will appreciably receive your help. All salaries are hereby suspended.**
